• Chief Meiman discussed an "Intent To Purchase" of a HazMat Apparatus being sold by Savage Volunteer Fire Department. The Chief read into record the letter of Intent to Purchase. The HazMat Vehicle is being purchased for \$195,000.00 and is considered an Emergency Purchase due to being sold by a fire department and not a vendor. The purchase will not allow for a bidding process, will not require future purchases and includes no patents. There will also be shipping required to deliver the vehicle to our department and will be approximately \$3,600.00. After discussion -

- Chief Meiman recommended the following promotions:

- Chief Meiman discussed changes to the Organization Chart specifically within the Fire Prevention Bureau. After discussion he made the following recommendations:

 - ❖ Troy Kerr should be promoted to Deputy Fire Marshal
 - ❖ A drone program should be added to the Fire Prevention Bureau.

• Chief Meiman informed the Board that the department is in the process of testing candidates for the upcoming EMT Academy and will update the Board in the future on the progress of this process.
